There has been an update to the go-live date for the Eviti process with Aetna Better Health of WV.

The start date of the new process outlined below is now **August 1, 2020**.

Overview of Process Change

Purpose of Eviti Connect	To provide specialist review of oncology treatment plans including chemotherapy, radiation therapy and supportive medications
Uses of Eviti Connect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Access to the latest evidence-based guidelines for radiation and chemotherapy • Select from 3,800+ pre-built regimens, or customize treatments when necessary • Discuss open treatment plan reviews with Eviti’s clinical staff
Treatment Recommendations	Eviti Connect aggregates evidence-based recommendations from national government agencies, reports, and journal publications (including the NCCN Compendium, JCO, JNCI, Lancet, NEJM and JAMA)
Training	Late June 2020: Several training sessions will be available to help you become familiar with using Eviti Connect to submit treatment plans for review. The training schedule will be sent in a future communication.
New Process Effective Date	July 1, 2020
